Policy & Advocacy

The national and statewide focus on early childhood has catalyzed an increase in legislation aimed at ensuring quality early childhood is accessible to all children. This legislation often lacks an equity lens. KairosPDX seeks to work with our network in establishing a voice that can inform such policy.

How to help: Get involved by testifying and being present at events and meetings to draw attention to important issues related to education legislation and equity for all children.

Early Childhood Learning

KairosPDX hosts Early Learning events in the evenings for family and caregivers of children 0-5 to provide information on culturally-specific, research-based practices that enhance their ability to support the growth and development of children.

How to help: You and/or your organization can utilize your skills and expertise to facilitate an event. Since these events are open to the public, we also need assistance with planning and outreach.

Family Engagement

KairosPDX hosts meetings to help nurture a community of practice, coordinate and synthesize needs and assist in the articulation of policy change that can help the providers and caretakers be most effective at their craft. They also provide opportunities for families in North Portland and their children to learn and play together.

How to help: Assistance with planning, outreach, and the facilitation of these events is needed. We welcome organizations who would like to become partners as consistent sources of expertise and resources for our families.

Fund Development
